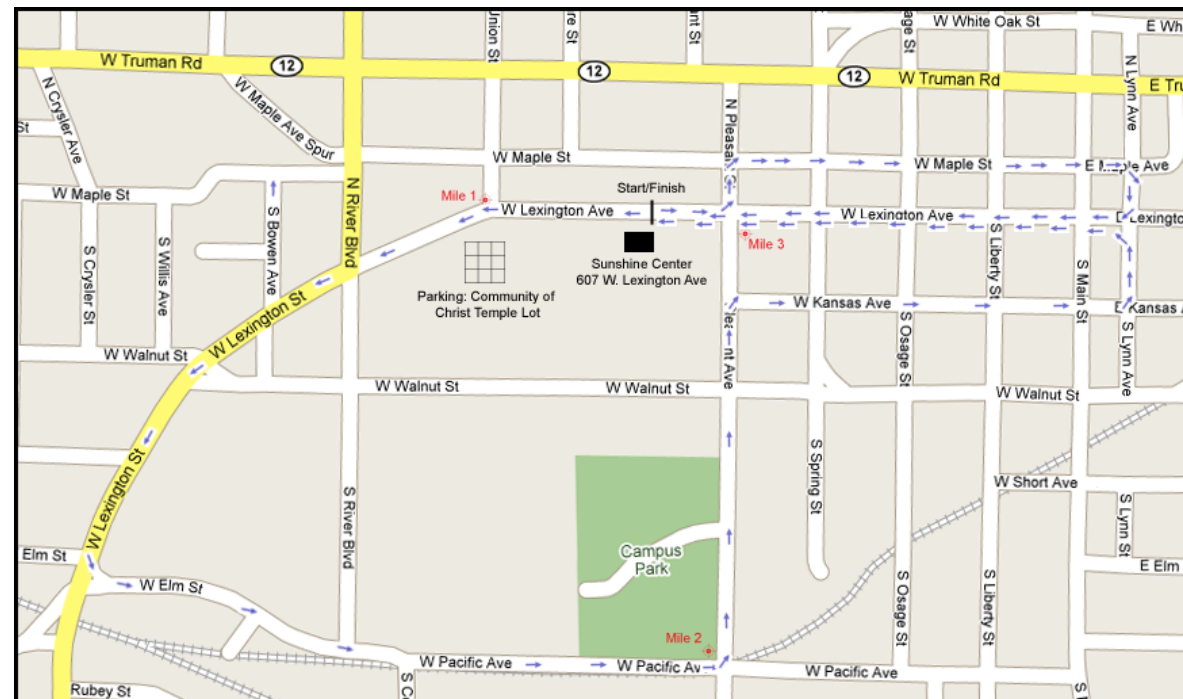

Course Description and Map

Lexington Street in front of Sunshine Center will close at 7:00a.m. The remaining roads around the course will begin closing at 7:30a.m. Get there early to avoid parking problems.

Parking is available at the Community of Christ Temple lot located one block west of Sunshine Center.

The race course starts and finishes at Sunshine Center, 607 W. Lexington Avenue. It is generally flat and makes a figure eight around the Independence Square and the Community of Christ Temple and Auditorium. There is one steep hill to run as you round the corner on to Pleasant Street at the second mile marker. The last quarter of mile grades downhill slightly, allowing for a strong finish.

Nativity of Mary School

Established in 1955, Nativity of Mary School is accredited by the National Federation of Non-Public School Accreditation Associations and North Central Association.
